Where Are You in Her Story?



Lynda Blackmon Lowery grew up in the midst of the Civil Rights movement, coming of age at a time when young people of color would march on the front lines, expecting to be arrested. Her book, *Turning 15 on the Road to Freedom*, weaves a personal narrative through times and events that were larger and more significant than she understood as a teen. Today, when Lowery reflects on how those events have unfolded in her

life, she sees the roles played by many people in and around the movement.

The next meeting of REPAIR will be built around Lowery's story. We'll reflect on how her experience intersects with the story of race that each of carries, gaining deeper knowledge of ourselves and our society in the process.
